The petition must be filed with the Division of Agricultural Environmental Services, 3125 Conner Boulevard, Room 130, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1650 and a copy with the appropriate court of appeal, within 30 DAYS from the date this ORDER is filed with the Division of Agricultural Environmental Services at the above address. The appeal must be conducted in accordance with the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. An action for injunctive relief may be filed in the appropriate circuit court. The responsible management official (named below) was notified when the order was issued and was provided a copy.
